Journey Home Sanctuary

Ontario's first community sanctuary for dying, where death is met in nature, held in the hands of love and compassion.

WHY

Dying and death deserve reverence.

The Sanctuary will honour the wholeness of a person, their wishes and values reflective of who they are, while holding and supporting the people who love them.

Most people say they want to die at home, surrounded by those who matter to them. Too few get that. Too many face their final days in clinical spaces built for treatment, not for peace.

Journey Home Support exists to close that gap. We offer presence, dignity, and time to individuals and their support circles navigating illness, dying, and grief. Our reach today is limited by space alone. There is no home in our community built specifically to hold this moment with the care it deserves.

The Sanctuary changes that. It will be the first home-like setting in the region where dying is not rushed by schedules or hidden behind clinical walls, where families can gather, goodbyes can be honoured, and every person can meet their ending with dignity.

WHAT

A home, not a facility.

The Sanctuary is designed to feel like a home in nature, not an institution. Warm rooms for gathering. Quiet corners for reflection. Space outdoors for the rituals families need, from a fire lit in remembrance to a garden walk taken in silence.

Living rooms and fireside circles where families can be together, not stuck in a waiting room.



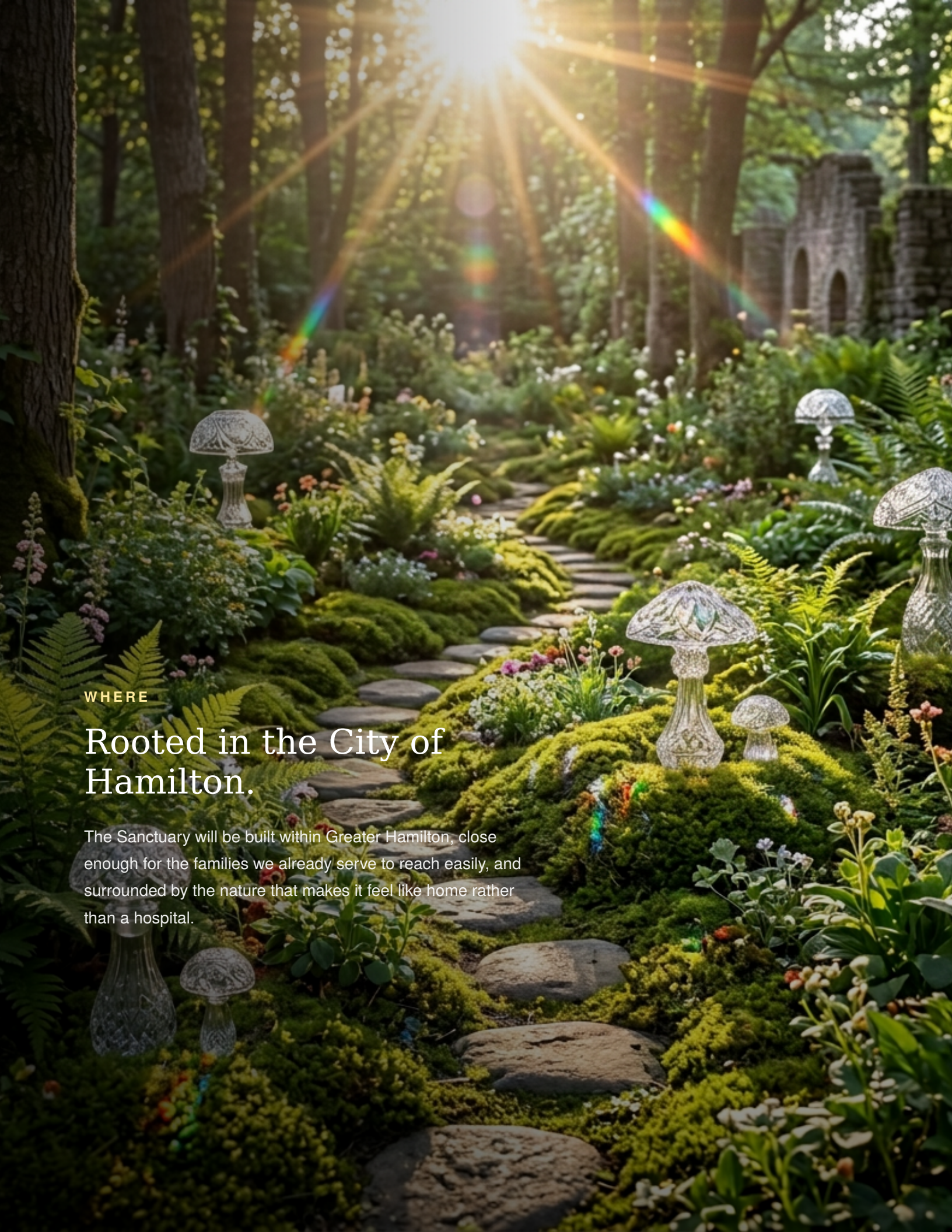
Space to be held
